The sign must have 3-inch reflective numbers mounted on a post at the beginning of your driveway, a minimum of 4-feet and a maximum of 6 feet high. We have been supplying the area with just the thing. Our signs have 3-inch white numbers on a 6 inch by 18-inch BLUE REFLECTIVE aluminum plate. We can also provide a post if you do not have any place to mount it. As a service to our elderly and disabled residents' installation is available upon request.
